

Welcome

Welcome to my third edition of the Chol Q'ij rendered onto the Gregorian Calendar. This calendar will help you to follow the sacred count of days of the Highland Maya people, bringing it into your everyday consciousness.

We tend to think of time as something that just happens, living our lives through the linear Gregorian 7 day week pattern. This pattern takes us out of harmony with our planet, the cycles of life and nature on this planet, and the cycles of the other planets in our solar system.

The Chol Q'ij, the Maya Sacred Calendar, takes these into account and helps us to organise our activities accordingly. There is nothing which dictates what must be done on certain days, just that there may be some auspicious days for certain activities. You can think of it rather like a weather forecast, only energetically. Imagine that you are organising an outdoor activity. Before the event, the weather forecast is for rain, so you can either mitigate for the effects of the rain by taking the appropriate equipment, choose another day for the activity, or press on regardless and just get wet. The Chol Q'ij helps us to prepare for the challenges we might face on certain days so that we can approach them in a prepared way. It also helps us to use our energy wisely, carrying out the appropriate actions when the energy is most conducive to their success.

The following page gives a brief introduction to the names of the 20 days of the Chol Q'ij, together with some of their properties. This can help to give an idea of what activities might be carried out on which days, for example garden work on Q'anil days, legal matters on Tz'i days or business on Tz'ikin days.

I have included the lunar phases into the calendar, I have also included observable planets and meteor showers into the calendar. all timings and observations are made in UTC. This may also change the day on which certain astronomical events occur according to your time zone.
